

# Activities and Assessment

## Online Tests

Tests can be quickly created from a pool of previously created questions. Questions can also be reused in other tests.

Teachers have the option to randomise the questions, set time limits and choose whether the students can see their results immediately after completing the test.

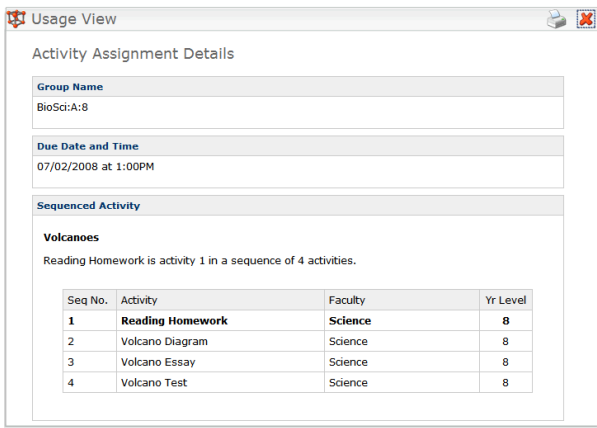

## Lesson Planning

Teachers can prepare entire lessons by sequencing multiple activities. These can be delivered to classes, individual users or adhoc groups of students.

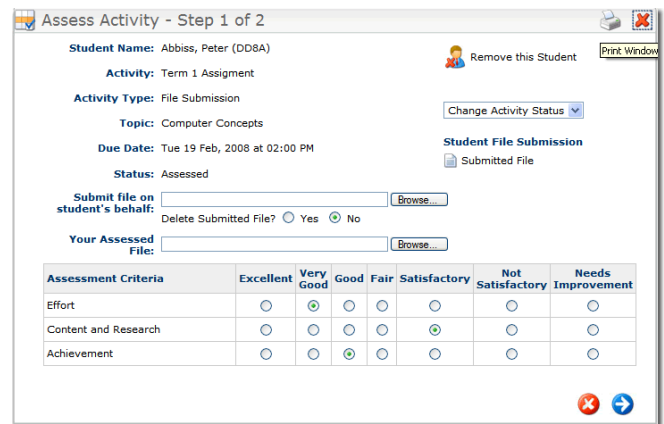
Activities are presented to the students one at a time. Once they complete an activity the next one is automatically assigned.



## Assessment Flexibility

Teachers can include their own assessment criteria and pre-defined grades. Free form text fields allow teaching staff to create their own criterion on which to assess students' activities.

Students receive their assessment results online. Possible feedback to students from teachers includes results, comments and/or uploaded assessed files

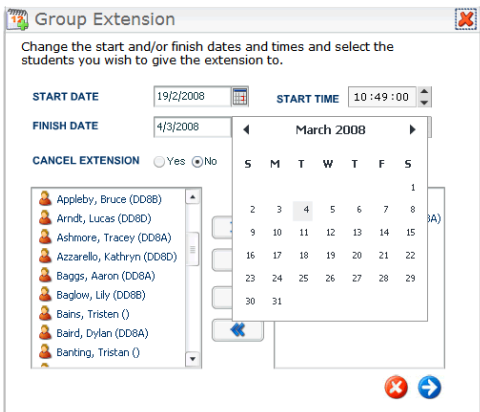


## Activity Status

Teachers have control over the changing of activity 'status' to cater for absentee students, special considerations or re-submission. The resubmit function can also be used to handle assignment drafts.

Delayed result dates allow teaching staff to nominate a date that assessment results will be delivered to students. This provides teachers with the time to complete group assessments before allowing results to be viewed.

Individual and group activity completion date extension functionality is also provided.
